Dear City of Earlville Residents,

The **City of Earlville** currently offers an 'opt out' electric municipal aggregation program to all residential and qualified small businesses. **Eligo Energy IL, LLC** ("Eligo"), a Chicago-based company, was selected as the new supplier for a 36-month contract term ending February 2022 for a rate of **6.774¢ per kWh**. This rate is significantly lower than ComEd's Price To Compare (PTC). This letter is being sent to you so that you may be informed of all your electric supply options.

To take advantage of the **City of Earlville** municipal electric aggregation program rate of 6.774¢ per kWh on your electricity supply through **February of 2022**, follow the instructions below.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

As an eligible member of this program, you will receive a fixed all-inclusive rate of **6.774¢ per kWh** on your electricity supply through **February of 2022**. There is no enrollment, switching, or early termination fee.

Before enrolling in the Program, you should compare the **City of Earlville** aggregation rate to the rate you are currently paying for electric supply to determine if you would benefit from participation in the Program.
